- Both prescription and non-prescription drugs must be in their original container. Prescription medications must be labeled by the pharmacist with appropriate dosing information. There will be no more than one medication per properly labeled container. *See attached form at the end of this packet*

**Things to Remember for the Trip**

- **Prepare for a busy trip:** Eat well, stay hydrated, and get plenty of sleep.
- **Communicate daily:** Check in with your parents each day with a quick text, thank them for their support, and stay in regular contact with your chaperones.
- **Bus restroom policy:** Use bus toilets only for emergencies. Do not dispose of trash—this helps keep the bus clean and odor-free.

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 **Student Survival Guide for a 19-Hour Bus Ride**

**1. Claim Your Comfort Early**

**Bring the “Big Three”:**

- Neck pillow (the memory foam kind is worth it)
- Small blanket or hoodie
- Eye mask + earplugs or noise-canceling headphones

Temperature and light change constantly on buses — be ready.

**2. Pack a “Go Bag” You Can Reach**

You don’t want to dig through the overhead compartment on a moving bus.

**Keep this in your seat bag:**

- Snacks that don’t melt or crumble (jerky, granola bars) **All food must be peanut/tree nut free.**
- Refillable water bottle
- Travel-size toiletries (a toothbrush like *Colgate Wisp*, wipes, **deodorant!!**)
- Portable charger + cables (there is no guarantee that the bus will have plugs)
- Hand sanitizer
- Shirt to change into at breakfast stop

**3. Manage Your Body**

**Hydrate—but strategically**

Sip throughout the trip, but avoid chugging to reduce restroom runs.

**Stretch every few hours**

When the bus stops:

- Walk around
- Roll your shoulders
- Stretch calves/hamstrings
- Do ankle rotations (prevents swelling)

**4. Entertainment Rotation Strategy**

Nineteen hours is too long to rely on just one thing.

**Load up before you leave:**

- Offline movies/shows (no R rated, even for yourself!)
- Music playlists
- Podcasts
- A book or Kindle
- A couple of games that work offline
- Something low-effort for when you’re tired (like puzzles or casual games)

Switch activities every 1–2 hours so you don’t burn out.

**5. Eat Smart**

Avoid foods that are:

- Super salty
- Greasy
- Likely to upset your stomach

Aim for snacks that keep you full and stable:

- Protein bars
- Fresh fruit
- Crackers
- **All food must be peanut/tree nut free**

Bus-stop food is off limits. We do not have time for 224 students to make purchases!

**6. Dress in Layers**

Bus AC is either set to **Antarctica** or **Tropical Jungle**. Never in-between.

Wear:

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- Comfy pants (athletic or joggers)
- T-shirt
- Hoodie/zip-up
- Socks you don't mind sleeping in

**7. Prepare for Sleep**

Even a couple good hours helps a ton.

Tips:

- Put pillow *between your shoulder and window* — more stable
- Recline *slightly* (don't be that person who goes full horizontal)
- Put on white noise or a quiet playlist
- Avoid caffeine after the first few hours

**8. Mental Prep: Set Expectations**

Long bus rides are tiring even when everything goes right.

Think of it as:

- A travel day, not a productive day
- A slow adventure
- Forced downtime (in a good way)

The right mindset helps a lot.

**Bonus: Things You'll Be Glad You Brought**

- A garbage-bag or plastic bag for your own trash
- Tissues
- A pen
- Backup headphones (trust me)

## HOW MUCH MONEY SHOULD I BRING?

## WHAT CAN I BRING INTO THE PARKS

AS LITTLE AS POSSIBLE. Travel light! You really won't want to carry anything more than your phone, your meal vouchers/cards, and whatever you plan to use for purchases. All parks offer day-use lockers you can rent if you need to store items during your visit.

- Backpack – optional
- Refillable water bottle – optional
- sunscreen - optional

## WHAT TO WEAR EACH DAY

Wear a maroon CRHS shirt, comfortable shorts or pants, and tennis shoes. (Remember: bus temperatures can vary)

Friday:

Wear the 2026 Spring trip shirt, comfortable shorts or pants, tennis shoes

Saturday (Parade Day):

Wear the 2025 Show Shirt, comfortable shorts or pants, tennis shoes

Sunday:

Wear a maroon CRHS shirt, comfortable shorts or pants tennis shoes

Monday:

Wear a maroon CRHS shirt, comfortable shorts or pants, and tennis shoes. (Remember: bus temperatures can vary)

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**General Trip Guidelines**

**Luggage & Packing**

- Label all luggage and instrument cases with your name, address, and phone number.
- Each person is allowed **one suitcase and one backpack only**.
- Make your luggage easily identifiable—especially since most bags are black.

**Schedule & Punctuality**

- Keep a copy of the itinerary with you at all times.
- Be punctual—wear a watch and plan ahead so the group never waits for you.

**Safety & Security**

- Stay alert with money and valuables; never leave belongings unattended.
- Always remain with at least **two other band members**—never go off alone.
- Handle merchandise honestly; shoplifting or suspicious behavior can lead to serious consequences.

**Conduct & Representation**

- Represent the Cinco Ranch Band with professionalism and courtesy at all times.
- Follow instructions from directors, chaperones, and supervising adults promptly and cheerfully.
- Public displays of affection are prohibited. Violations may result in disciplinary action.

**Hotel Rules**

- Only assigned students may enter a room.
- Keep rooms neat and clean; any damage is the student's responsibility.
- Pay-per-view items (movies, games, room service, outside deliveries) are off-limits.
- Chaperones may inspect rooms at any time.
- Curfew will be strictly enforced; doors will be taped. Leaving your room after curfew or being late may result in loss of privileges or being sent home.
- Remain courteous to other guests and keep noise to a minimum.
- Do not congregate in hallways.
- **Hotel pool is off-limits**—there is no time scheduled for swimming.

**Health & Wellness**

- If sick in a park, find the nearest first aid station and contact your chaperone.
- Report illness or injury immediately to a chaperone.
  - Let chaperones handle the next steps – don't wander, don't try to tough it out.
- Prescription medications must be kept with directors and taken at scheduled times.
- Get adequate sleep so you are ready for daily activities.

**Legal & Ethical Behavior**

- Use appropriate language at all times. You are representing CINCO RANCH every moment you wear that shirt—make sure your words reflect that.
- Follow all park and hotel rules without exception.
- Violations of local, state, or federal laws will result in removal from the trip and referral to campus administration.
